\$2.7M in mortgage and rent assistance has been provided statewide to Arizona families to keep them in their homes

1,025 AZ families (2,725 children and 1,856 adults) spent 1,296,013 nights secure in their homes during a health and financial crisis

27% of families are single head of household



63% of children served were under the age of five

ARIZONA TAX CREDIT FOR QUALIFYING CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS

Care Fund is recognized by the Arizona Department of Revenue as a Qualifying Charitable Organization. Care Fund donors who pay income tax in Arizona may claim the tax credit support for QCOs. Eligible contributions made on or before April 15th may be applied to either the current or the preceding taxable year.

Taxpayers filing as:

Single and Head of Household status may claim a maximum credit of \$400 Married filing separate may claim a maximum credit of \$400
